## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

All applicants are required to undergo an interview with the Student Services Advisor or Programme Coordinator.

Minimum 17 years have passed at least NCEA L2 60 credits or equivalent (preferably including Biology).

No communicable disease conditions, or physical or psychological impairments that may adversely affect the ability to undertake a practical and theoretical programme of study, or work with people in a clinical setting.

All applicants must be able to competently communicate in English.

International students whose first language is not English must have a minimum overall IELTS (Academic) score of 5.5 with no band lower than 5.0, or equivalent evidence of English language competency.

International students must be on shore in Aotearoa New Zealand and study on campus, and complete all immigration requirements including evidence of appropriate medical and travel insurance and a valid Student Visa.
